

## DESIGN FOR POCKET-BOOK FASTENERS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,948, dated April 24, 1877; application filed March 13, 1877. [Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Louis Prahar, of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new and original Design for Fastenings for Pocket-Books, &c., of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying drawing, to which reference is made.

The fastening is an octagonal frame com-

posed of straight bars A C D F, and a rounded part, E.

What I claim is—
The design for a pocket book fastening, shown and described.
