

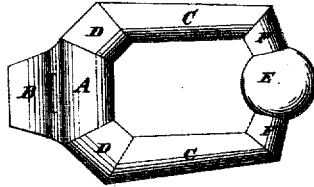

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, LOUIS PRAHAR, of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new and original Design for Fastenings for Pocket-Books, &c., of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying drawing, to which reference is made.

The fastening is an octagonal frame com-

posed of straight bars A C D F, and a rounded part, E.
