

DESIGN FOR FANCY CASSIMERES.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,990, dated May 15, 1877; application filed May 2, 1877. [Term of Patent 31 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CHARLES KIMBALL, manufacturer, of Mohegan, town of Burrillville, in the county of Providence and State of Rhode Island, have invented certain new and useful Improvements in Designs in Fancy Cassimeres; and I do hereby declare that the following is a full, clear, and exact description thereof, which will enable others skilled in the art to which it appertains to make and use the same, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, and to the letters of reference marked thereon, which form a part of this specification.

The following is a description of the within

design:

A represents stripes made by a plain weave running lengthwise of the fabric, and having spots woven in the center, formed by the warp being thrown on the face.

B represents narrowstripes made by a plain weave running lengthwise of the piece.

C represents a stripe running lengthwise of the fabric, formed by a double diagonal weave, showing both warp and weft on the face.

I claim as my invention-
