

DESIGN FOR BUSINESS-DIRECTORY BOARDS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10.006, dated May 22, 1877; application filed March 19, 1877. [Term of Patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM H. THACKE-BAY, of Pittsburg, in the county of Allegheny, State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new and original Design for Business-Directory Boards, of which the following is a full and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying photographic illustration, forming a part of this specification.

A represents the main portion of the bulletin-board, around which extends the ornamental border B. This board is divided into the spaces C C and central space D. Above this main board is the circular headboard E, provided with ornamental border F, scroll-work G G, depending scroll-sheet H,

and panels I K. The top of the head-board is provided with a concavity, L, containing the ornamental acorn M.

What I claim is-

The design for advertising bulletin-boards, consisting of main board A, having ornamental border B and spaces C C and D, and head board E, provided with ornamental border F, scroll-work G G, depending scroll-sheet H, and panels I K, and concavity L, with ornamental acorn M, as shown and described
