

DESIGN FOR FANCY CASSIMERES.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10.013, dated May 29, 1877; application filed May 10, 1877. [Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Francis Carpenter, manufacturer, of Glendale, town of Burrill-ville, in the county of Providence and State of Rhode Island, have invented certain new and useful Improvements in Designs in Fancy Cassimeres; and I do hereby declare that the following is a full, clear, and exact description thereof, which will enable others skilled in the art to which it appertains to make and use the same, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, and to the letters of reference marked thereon, which form a part of this specification.

The design is shown by accompanying photograph, of which the following is a description:

A represents a stripe of plain weave, hav-

ing a row of spots running down the center, formed by the warp being thrown on the face. B represents a cord line on each side of stripe A, and formed by the filling being thrown upon the face. C shows a narrower striping, formed by the warp being thrown on the face. D represents a wide stripe, formed by warp and filling both being thrown on the face.

I claim as my invention as above described, and shown by the accompanying photograph.
