DESIGN FOR SPIRIT-LEVELS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,015, dated May 29, 1877; application filed May 15, 1877.

[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, LEONARD L. DAVIS, of Springfield, in the county of Hampden and State of Massachusetts, have invented certain Improvements in Design for a Combined Spirit-Level, Plumb, and Inclinometer, of which the following is a specification:

My invention consists of a design for a combined spirit-level, plumb, and inclinometer, as hereinafter described, and as shown in the accompanying photograph, making part of this specification.

This design consists of a top and bottom plate, A A, made flat and true on their edges and exterior faces, with any suitable style of molding or ornamentation on their inner and opposing faces. These two plates A A are connected by a series of rungs or rounds, C, as shown, and centrally or midway of the

length of the plates is located a ring, B, within which is located the movable spiritube. The style or form of the rounds C, as also their number, may be varied without materially changing the general appearance or character of the design, which consists, essentially, of the two plates A A, connected by the rounds C and the central ring B, all arranged substantially as shown in the accompanying photograph.

What I claim is---

The herein described design, consisting of the plates A A, with the central ring B and the rounds C, all arranged substantially as shown in the accompanying photograph. LEONARD L. DAVIS.
