DESIGN FOR CARPET.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,035, dated June 5, 1877; application filed May 26, 1877.
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HUGH S. KERR, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have produced or invented a new and original Design for a Carpet-Pattern, of which the following is a specification:

The accompanying photographic illustration shows sufficient of a carpet-pattern to illustrate my design, which comprises a bunch of leaves and blossoms, *a*, beneath which is looped a spray, *b*, of stems and flowers, the whole being arranged upon a mottled ground-work.

Irrespective of the colors employed, I claim—
The design for a carpet-pattern, substantially as described, and as shown in and by the accompanying drawing.
