

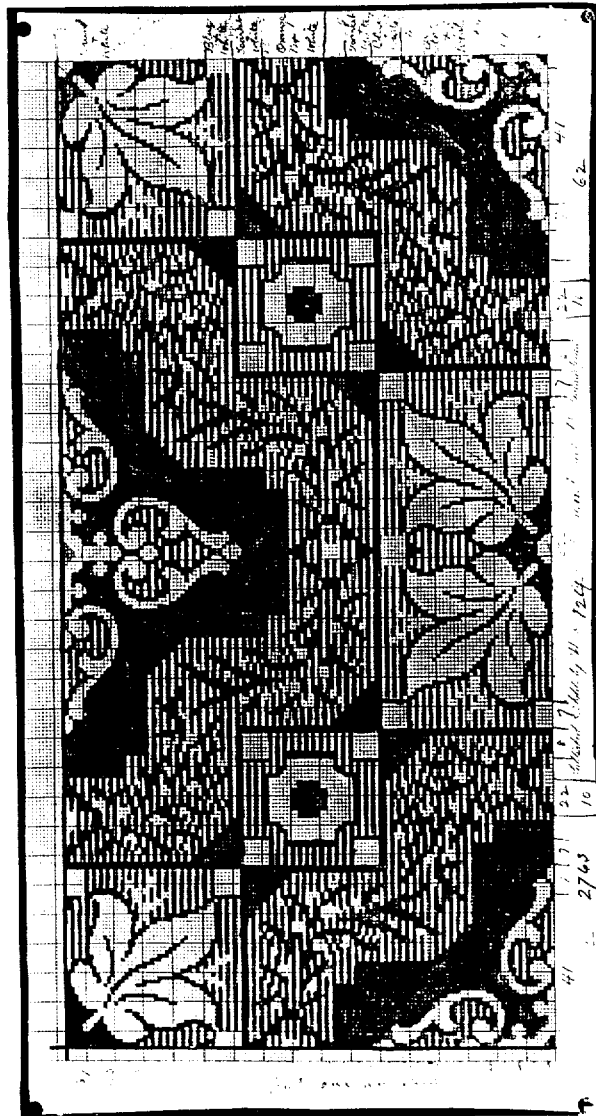

## DESIGN FOR CARPET.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,037**, dated June 5, 1877; application filed May 26, 1877.  
[Term of Patent  $3\frac{1}{4}$  years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, HUGH S. KERR, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have produced or invented a new and original Design for a Carpet-Pattern, of which the following is a specification:

The accompanying photographic illustration shows sufficient of a carpet-pattern to indicate the design, the main feature of which is the figure A, which is shaped somewhat like a Greek cross, is provided with interior ornamentation *a*, and surrounded by a ground-work, *b*, ornamented with sprays.

The remainder of the pattern is occupied by square figures B, having foliated interior decoration, and by small squares D, which have

the appearance of resting on broad bands *d*, which extend from corner to corner of the larger squares B.

Irrespective of the colors employed, I claim—

The design for a carpet-pattern, substantially as described, and as shown in and by the accompanying drawing.
