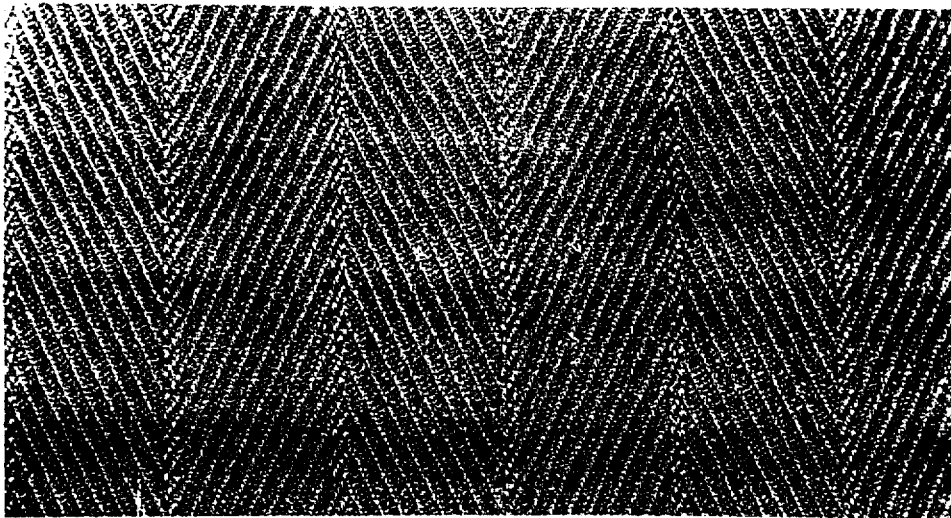

DESIGN FOR CASSIMERES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,056**, dated June 19, 1877; application filed June 4, 1877.
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CHAS. F. HARRISON, of New York city, in the county of New York and State of New York, have originated and designed a Design in Cassimeres; and do hereby declare that the following is a full, clear, and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying photographs, (drawings,) which form a part of this specification.

The design is shown by accompanying photograph, of which the following is a description:

A represents small stripe running warpwise and striping the pattern lengthwise, composed of small diagonal bars running from right to left. B represents wide stripes running warpwise and striping the pattern lengthwise, composed of small diagonal stripes run-

ning from right to left, and forming apices in stripe A with small diagonal stripes of wide stripe represented by C. C represents wide stripe, running warpwise and striping the pattern lengthwise, composed of small diagonal stripes running from left to right, and forming apices in stripe A with small diagonal stripes of wide stripe represented by B.

I claim as my invention—
