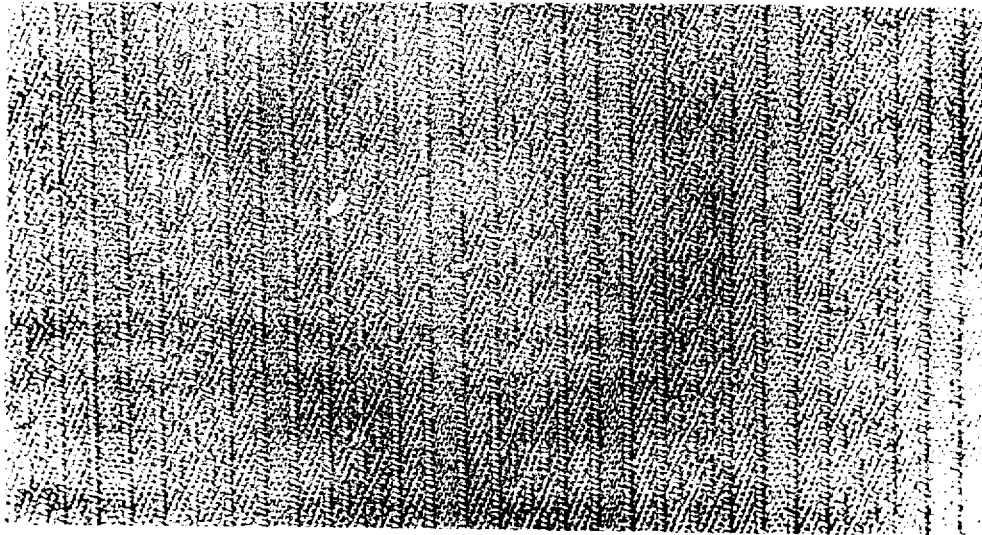

DESIGN FOR CASSIMERES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,089**, dated July 3, 1877; application filed June 22, 1877.
[Term of Patent $3\frac{1}{4}$ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, OSCAR F. CHASE, of Thompson, in the county of Windham and State of Connecticut, have originated and designed a Pattern for Cassimeres; and I do hereby declare that the following is a full, clear, and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying photographs, which form a part of this specification.

The design is shown by the accompanying photograph, of which the following is a description.

A represents a triple stripe, formed by four (4) narrow stripes running warpwise, and three (3) wider stripes running warpwise, two (2) of which are composed of very narrow diagonal stripes, and the middle stripe woven so as to form an interlacing chain, in contrast with the two stripes formed of small

diagonal stripes, the whole striping the pattern lengthwise.

B represents a wide stripe, formed by a double diagonal weave or twisted cord, and the interspaces so woven as to form small elongated bars, arranged diagonally between the double diagonal weave or twisted cord, also striping the pattern lengthwise.

I claim as my invention—

The above-described design, as shown by photograph, in any colors desired.
