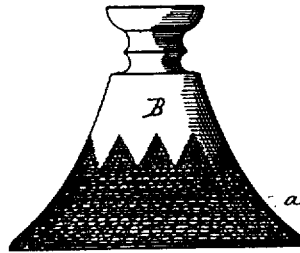

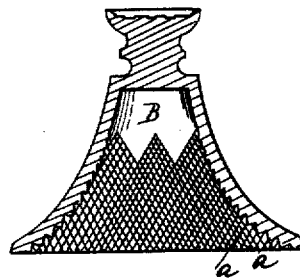
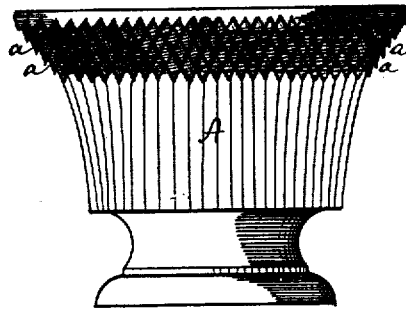

DESIGN FOR GLASSWARE.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,096**, dated July 17, 1877; application filed July 7, 1877.
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JENKIN JONES, of the city of Pittsburg, in the county of Allegheny and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new and useful Design for Glassware; and I do hereby declare the following to be a full, clear, and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part of this specification, in which—

Figure 1 is an elevation of an article of glassware ornamented in accordance with my invention. Fig. 2 is a sectional view of the same.

My invention relates to a design of ornamentation for glassware; and consists of what I term "pearls," produced by dotting or studding the ware in any given pattern or form with a series of projecting points closely arranged or grouped, thereby producing a peculiar, novel, and pleasing effect.

In the drawing, A indicates the bowl, and B the cover, of a glass article, the cover and flange or mouth of the bowl being studded with points *a*, through which the light passes with prismatic effect.

The article chosen for illustration having been formed mainly in a drop-mold, the design or ornamentation has been confined to the cover and bell-mouth of the bowl; but it is evident that the effect may be produced on any part of an article, and extended to all parts thereof by a proper construction of partible molds.

Having thus described my invention, what I claim, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

As a design for glassware, the effect produced by a series of points or prisms closely and systematically arranged, substantially as specified.
