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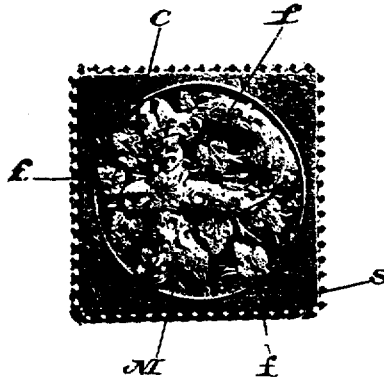

DESIGN FOR BUTTONS, STUDS, &c.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,100**, dated July 17, 1877; application filed June 23, 1877.
[Term of Patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern :

Be it known that we, JAMES W. MILLER and ISAAC M. MILLER, of Newark, county of Essex, State of New Jersey, have originated a useful Design for Buttons, Studs, Locketts, Charms, Pins, and Ear-Rings, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying photographic illustration, making part of this specification.

S represents the body or base of the button, stud, locket, charm, pin, and ear-ring, which is square-shaped. M represents a circular depressed center in the base S. C represents a rustic letter mounted on the circular depressed center M, and may be any letter of

the alphabet. The rustic letter C and the circular depressed center M are to be ornamented with vines and leaves, portions of which are represented at *fff*.

We claim as our invention—

A design for a button, stud, locket, charm, pin, and ear-rings, consisting of the square base S, with a circular depressed center, represented at M, which is mounted with a rustic letter C, or ornamented as at *fff*, substantially in the manner above described.
