DESIGN FOR CASINGS OF SODA-WATER APPARATUS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,137, dated July 31, 1877; application filed July 5, 1877. [Term of Patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JAMES W. TUFTS, of Medford, in the county of Middlesex and State of Massachusetts, have invented and produced a new and original Design for the Casing of a Soda-Water Apparatus, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, ref erence being had to the accompanying photograph, making part of this specification.

In the photograph, A represents the casing of a soda-water apparatus, the base of which is of rectangular form. The front and rear sides a b extend up vertically, while each of the two opposite ends c is beveled or inclined inward from the base to the flat top or cover d, thus relieving the casing of the square or box-like appearance which would be presented if the ends c extended upward in vertical plane. The front and rear plates a b are each beveled or inclined from e to f, to correspond to the inclination of the ends c, and are each

provided with an ornamental top or projection, g, sloping on each side from the point fto the apex h, a unique and ornamental design being thus produced.

If desired, the casing A may be embellished with panels or tablets, to give it a more highly. finished appearance.

What I claim as my invention, and desire

to secure by Letters Patent, is-

The design of the casing A, having vertical front and rear sides a b, with ornamental projections g, sloping on each side from the point f to the apex h, and inwardly and upwardly inclined ends c, substantially as herein shown and described.
