

DESIGN FOR ADVERTISING-CARDS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,152, dated August 14, 1877; application filed June 21, 1877. [Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, James D. Holt, of Philadelphia, in the county of Philadelphia and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a certain new and useful Design for Advertising-Card; and I do hereby declare the following to be a full, clear, and exact description of the design, such as will enable others skilled in the art to which it pertains to make and use it, reference, being had to the accompanying drawings, which form part of this specification, in which—

Figures 1 and 2 are, respectively, front and rear outside views. Fig. 3 is a perspective of my design, showing the inside pages of the card.

My design consists of two sheets of paper, cut and stamped or embossed or printed to represent a pair of gloves, said sheets being intended to be fastened together in pairs, in such manner that the stamped, printed, or embossed part aforesaid, representing the lines between the fingers, the slit and buttons at the wrist, &c., will be outside. On the inside of one of the sheets is delineated two babes, and the inscription "A pair of kids."

The inside of the other sheet is left for the reception of any arbitrary matter or advertisement.

In the accompanying drawings, A A' represent two sheets of paper, stamped, embossed, printed, or colored at a and a', to represent, respectively, the back and front of a kid glove or pair of gloves. B represents the babes, and C the suggestive legend referring thereto, and to the articles on which they are delineated. D is the side for advertisement.

What I claim as my invention is-

The design for a kid-glove advertisement or business-card, consisting of the pair of imitation gloves, having delineated on the inside of one two babes, as herein shown and described.
