

DESIGN FOR A PATTERN IN SUITINGS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,158, dated August 21, 1877; application filed July 25, 1877. [Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, NATHAN FRYE, of Andover, in the county of Essex and State of Massachusetts, have originated and designed a Pattern of Suitings; and I do hereby declare that the following is a full, clear, and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying photographs, which form a part of this specification.

A represents ground of pattern, and is perfectly plain, showing warp and weft in any colors desired. B represents small raised dots running in diagonal lines, every alternate dot

being transposed, and the whole having the effect of a basket-weave, and showing warp and weft in any colors desired.

I claim as my invention-

The above described design, as shown by accompanying photograph.
