## DESIGN FOR BACKS OF PLAYING-CARDS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,238, dated September 11, 1877; application filed August 4, 1877. [Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ALFRED J. MANNING, of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented and produced a new Design for the Backs of Playing-Cards, of which the

following is the specification:

A molded border, B, incloses an oblong ornamental panel, A, formed by a molded border, a, as shown. The corner-pieces C are ornamented by vines and leaves, as shown. In the center of the large panel A is an ornamental cross, b, arranged within a smaller panel, D, surrounded by an ornamental border, c, as shown. The space between the borders a c is occupied by foliated ornaments s, as shown.

I claim—

1. The design for the back of a playing. card, consisting of the panel A, its border B, and corners C, ornamented by vines and leaves, substantially as shown and described.

2. The design for the back of a playingcard, consisting of the panel D, substantially as shown and described.

3. The design for the back of a playingcard, consisting of the ornamental cross b, substantially as shown and described.

4. The design for the back of a playingcard, consisting of the panel A, having the border inclosing the ornamental figures, substantially as shown and described.
