

DESIGN FOR BACKS OF PLAYING-CARDS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,242, dated September 11, 1877; application filed August 4, 1877.

[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ALFRED J. MANNING, of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented and produced a new Design for the Backs of Playing-Cards, of which the following is the specification:

The central panel A is of the form shown, and is inclosed within a border, a, forming therewith corner-pieces B, within which are radiating stems i. Cross-stems e, in the center of the panel, terminate in leaf-like figures f, and from each of the latter extends a flower, f', as shown. Curved lines c, extending between the flowers, inclose a mottled centerpiece, h.

I claim—

1. The design for the back of a playingcard, consisting of the border a inclosing cor-

ner-pieces B, ornamented by radiating stems *i*, substantially as shown and described.

2. The design for the back of a playingcard, consisting of a panel containing the cross-stems e, leaves f, and flowers f', and mottled center-piece h, substantially as shown and described.

3. The design for the back of a playing-card, consisting of the center-piece having the cross-stems and leaves f, substantially as described and shown.
