To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ALFRED J. MANNING, of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented and produced a new Design for the Backs of Playing-Cards, of which the following is the specification:

A is the panel, having a central star-like figure, a, and inclosing a series of open lilies, b, lily buds c, and leaves i, grouped as shown.

I claim—

The design for the back of a playing-card,

consisting of open lilies, lily-buds, and leaves, grouped, substantially as shown and described.
