

DESIGN FOR BACKS OF PLAYING-CARDS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,245, dated September 11, 1877; application filed August 4, 1877.

[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ALFRED J. MANNING, of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented and produced a new Design for the Backs of Playing Cards, of which the following is the specification:

lowing is the specification:

The border-lines a are continued to form the central panel A, of the shape shown, and the corner pieces B, within each of which is a scroll, terminating in three leaves, c. In the center of the panel is a star, d, from which radiate leaves e, lying upon a dark circle, c'.

I claim-

1. The design for the back of a playingcard, consisting of the panel A having the border α of the outline, substantially as shown and described.

2. The design for the back of a playing.

card, consisting of the panel A formed of a continuation of the outer border a, substantially as shown and described.

3. The design for the back of a playingcard, consisting of the corner-pieces B ornamented by scrolls and leaves, substantially as shown and described.

4. The design for the back of a playing-card, consisting of the center-piece having a star, d, and radiating leaves e, substantially as shown and described.
