

DESIGN FOR BACKS OF PLAYING-CARDS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,246, dated September 11, 1877; application filed August 4, 1877.

[Term of Patent 7 years.]

. To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ALFRED J. MANNING, of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented and produced a new Design for the Backs of Playing-Cards, of which the following is the specification:

A is the central panel, and B a surrounding border, composed of oval figures a. A waved vine, b, ornamented by leaves t, running through said figures, is inclosed within borderlines c' c''.

In the center of the panel is a rosette, C, forming the center of a dark cross, d, inclosed by a border, e.

A ribbon, i, forming a continuation of the border c', runs through the panel, as shown, and at the corners of panel are lattice-like corner-pieces h.

I claim-

1. The design for the back of a playing card, consisting of a panel containing the cross d, rosette C, and ribbon i, as specified and shown.

2. The design for the back of a playing-card, consisting of a center-piece having the panel d, substantially as shown and described.

3. The design for the back of a playing-card, consisting of a border having the oval figures a and vine b, as specified and shown.

4. The design for the back of a playing-card, consisting of the panel composed of the rosette C, cross d, ribbon i, and corner-pieces h, as shown and described.

5. The design for the back of a playing-card, consisting of the waved border-line b and its leaves t, substantially as shown and described.
