DESIGN FOR LAMP CHIMNEYS OR GLOBES.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,254, dated September 18, 1877; application filed September 3, 1877. [Term of Patent 31 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, PAUL ZIMMERMAN, of Pittsburg, in the county of Allegheny and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new and useful Improvement in Design for Lamp Chimneys or Globes; and I do hereby declare the following to be a full, clear, and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part of this specification, in which is shown an elevation of a lamp and combined lamp chimney and globe, showing my invention.

My invention consists of a lamp chimney or globe having a double series of spiral lines or bands crossing each other, cut, engraved, pressed, or otherwise formed thereon, giving a beautiful and unique appearance, especially

when the lamp is lighted.

In the drawing, A represents the lamp chimney or globe, on which are two series of spiral lines. The lines of each series may be parallel or at any angle to each other that may be desired.

What I claim as my improved design, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is-

A lamp chimney or globe having a double series of spiral lines or bands crossing each other, substantially as shown or described.
