DESIGN FOR A FONT OF ORNAMENTAL PRINTING-TYPES.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,257, dated September 18, 1877; application filed May 24, 1877.

[Term of Patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Julius Herriet, of the city and county of New York and State of New York, have originated and designed a new Design or Pattern for a Font of Ornamental Printing-Types, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is clearly shown in the accompanying typographic impression, to which reference is made; and consists of lowercase and capital letters, points, and figures.

It is supplementary to the design for which Letters Patent No. 4,990, dated June 13, 1871, have already been granted me, and differs from that and from every other design of its class because of having its heavy or body lines greatly increased in weight or thickness, the weight or thickness, length or size of the crosslines, ceriphs, and disks or balls being correspondingly increased, and because of being wider or more extended.

What I claim as my invention, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design or pattern for a font of ornamental printing-types, as shown and described.
