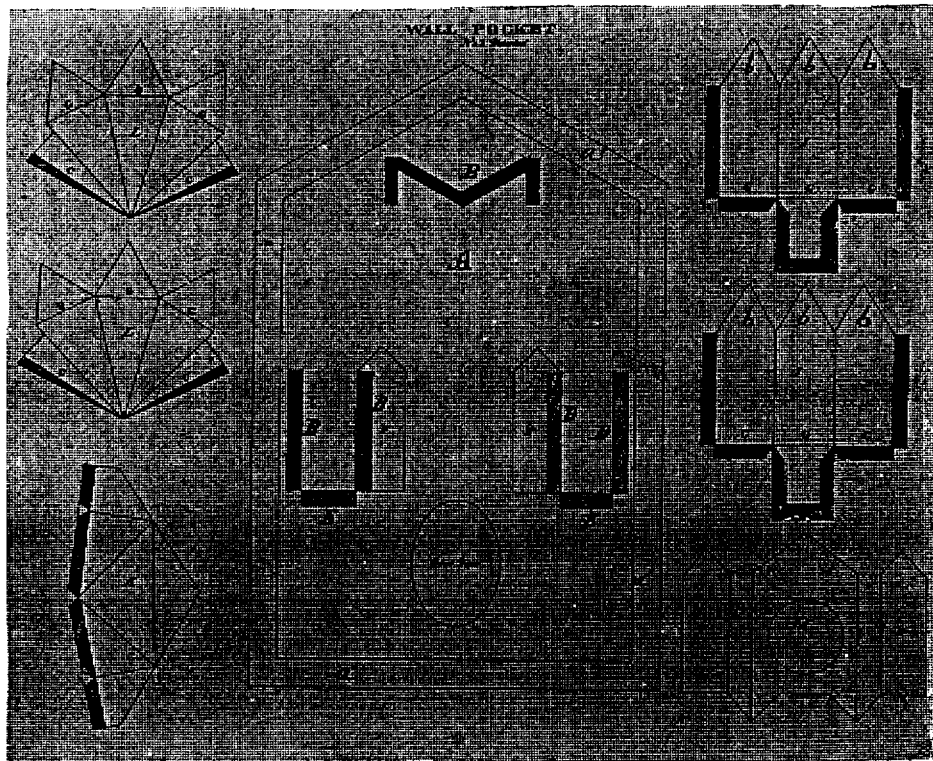

DESIGN FOR A WALL-POCKET PATTERN.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,271**, dated October 9, 1877; application filed July 28, 1877.
[Term of Patent $3\frac{1}{4}$ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM HAMILTON, of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new and Improved Design for Wall-Pocket Blank, of which the following is a specification:

My invention consists of a pattern or outline for a wall-pocket printed upon perforated card, so that it may be cut out and worked with worsted and the various parts united by paste or mucilage and by sewing, to form an ornamental pocket for the reception of a watch or matches and other articles.

In the accompanying illustration, A represents the back of the pocket, having the border-line a' and the heavy line B D E, which indicate the place to which the similarly-marked parts of the pockets I K are attached.

The outlines for the pockets I have three angles, b , which form a Gothic finish at the upper end of the pockets when they are bent into a rectangular form and attached to the back A.

L is an outline upon which to cut a blank, which, when properly united and attached to the pockets I, forms an inverted pyramid, which finishes the lower portion of the pockets. K is the outline of a shallow pocket that is attached to the upper portion of the back, and M is the outline of a watch-pocket.

An ellipse indicates a place for sand-paper, and the various parts are provided with lines, upon which they are bent or folded.

Having thus described my invention, I claim as new and desire to secure by Letters Patent—

The design for a wall-pocket pattern formed of the border a' , the lines B D E, and the several outlines I K L M, as described, and shown in the accompanying illustration.
