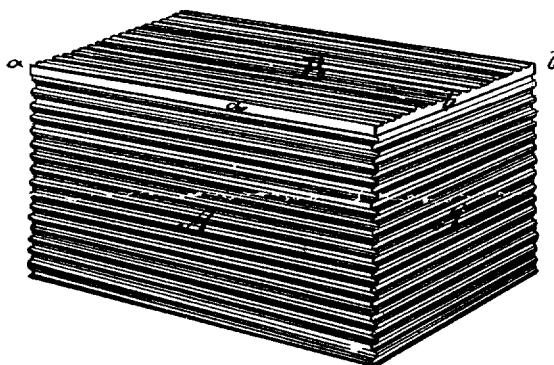

DESIGN FOR CIGAR-BOX.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,275**, dated October 16, 1877; application filed September 24, 1877.
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GUSTAV FUCHS, of New York city, in the county and State of New York, have invented a new and original Design for a Cigar-Box, of which the following is a specification:

The drawing represents a perspective view of my new design for a cigar-box.

The invention relates to a new configuration of cigar-box, having a flat, unflanged top.

It consists in the use of corrugated sides and ends, and of a corrugated top or cover, the edges of said top or cover being straight and flat, as hereinafter specified.

In the drawing, the letter A represents the body of the cigar-box, and B its flat, unflanged

top or cover. The cover is corrugated at its upper surface, but its edges *a b* are flat, as shown. The ends and sides of the body are also corrugated, as shown. A very peculiar and original effect is thus produced.

I claim as my invention—

The design for a cigar-box having an unflanged cover, the said design consisting of the corrugated body A, combined with the cover B, which is corrugated on top, but made with flat edges *a b*, substantially as shown.
