

DESIGN FOR BASKET TEA-POTS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,313, dated November 13, 1877; application filed July 21, 1877.

[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOHN E. JEFFORDS, of Philadelphia, in the county of Philadelphia and State of Pennsylvania, have originated and designed a Pattern for Basket Tea-Pots; and I do hereby declare that the following is a full, clear, and exact description of the construction and operation of the same, reference being had to the annexed photograph, making a part of this specification, and to the letters and figures of reference marked thereon.

A represents the body of the tea-pot; B, the spout, and C the handle. These may be of

any of the usual forms.

The body of the pot is ornamented with the representation of wicker-work in cameo, over which, as though overflowing the said pot, is a design representing foliage. The spout is covered with the representation of wickerwork of less size, and the lid with foliage, which is also in cameo, and in continuation of that upon the body of the pot, surmounted by the representation of an acorn and its cup.

What I claim as my invention is-

1. A design for an earthenware tea pot, in which the body of the pot is covered by the representation of wicker-work, having at its upper part the representation of foliage, the lid covered with the representation of foliage, in continuation of that of the body, and the spout with the representation of wicker-work, substantially in the manner above set forth.

2. A design for a tea-pot, wherein the body of the pot is covered with the representation of wicker-work and foliage, substantially in

the manner specified.
