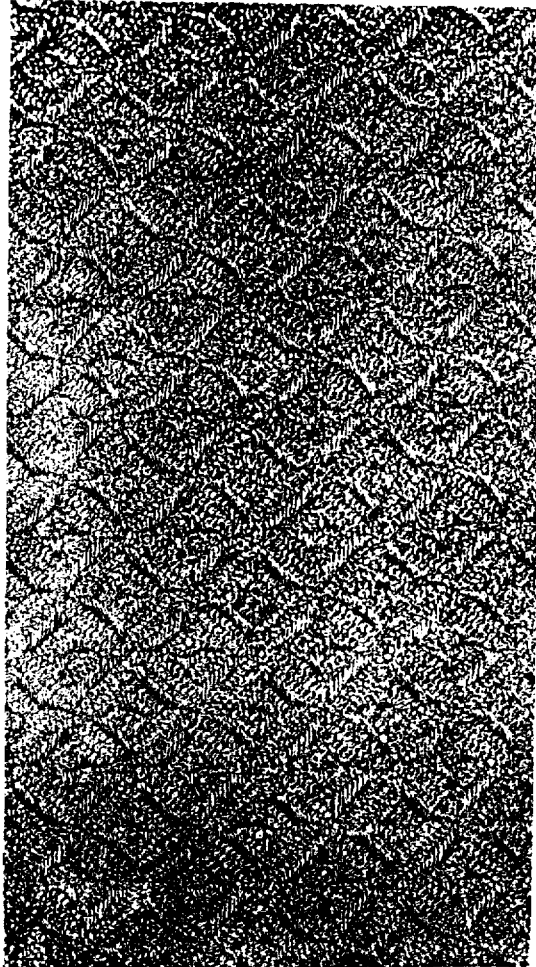

DESIGN FOR CASSIMERES FOR CLOAKINGS.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HORACE A. KIMBALL, of Providence, in the county of Providence and State of Rhode Island, have originated and designed a Pattern in Cassimeres for Cloaking; and I do hereby declare that the following is a full, clear, and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying photographs, which form a part of this specification.

A represents the surface of the cloth, which is covered by a series of narrow indented stripes running warpwise. These stripes form the termini of a series of diagonal curved bars woven in the weft. Said diagonal bars, from

both right to left and left to right, reverse their curves alternately, thus forming irregular squares. In the center of each square is woven two connected triangular spots.

I claim as my invention—

The design as above described, and shown by the accompanying photographs.
