

DESIGN FOR BUCKLES.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,323, dated November 20, 1877; application filed October 2, 1877. [Term of Patent 34 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILBUR F. OSBORNE, of Ansonia, in the county of New Haven and State of Connecticut, have invented a new Design for Buckles; and I do hereby declare the following, when taken in connection with the accompanying drawing and the letters of reference marked thereon, to be a full, clear, and exact description of the same, and which said drawing constitutes part of this specification, and represents a face view.

This invention relates to a design for the frame of a buckle, with special reference to that class known as "lever-buckles;" and the design consists in the representation of a shield on one of the bars of the buckle, as hereinafter

described, and shown in the accompanying illustration.

The general outline of the frame does not differ essentially from the usual construction. On one of the bars a a projection is made, both above and below, representing a shield, b, as upon the face of the bar a.

I claim—
The design for buckle, consisting of the representation of a shield, b, on the inner bar of the frame, as shown in the accompanying illustration.
