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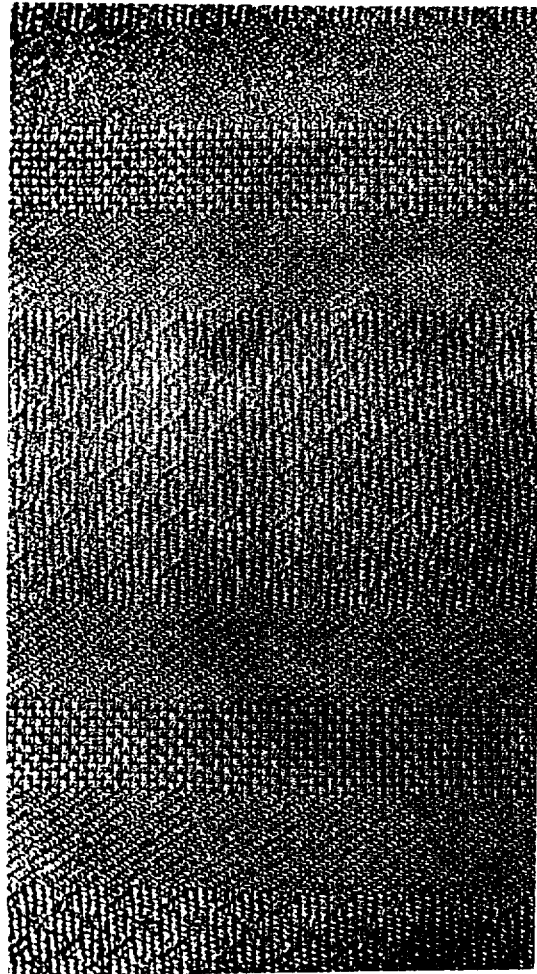

## DESIGN FOR FANCY CASSIMERES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,326**, dated November 27, 1877; application filed November 15, 1877.  
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, OSCAR F. CHASE, of Thompson, in the county of Windham and State of Connecticut, have originated and designed a new style for Fancy Cassimeres; and I do hereby declare that the following is a full, clear, and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying photograph, which forms a part of this specification:

A'' represents a wide stripe, running warp-wise, composed of a series of bars running obliquely from right to left and from left to right, forming irregular diamond-shaped figures.

B'' represents a narrow stripe, striping the pattern in the same manner as stripe A'', woven in ribs, running from left to right.

C'' represents a narrow stripe, adjacent to stripe B'', different in character, and resembling basket-work; also striping the pattern lengthwise.

I claim as my invention—

The design as above described and shown in the accompanying photograph.
