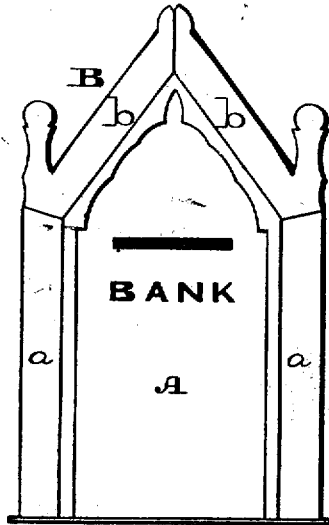

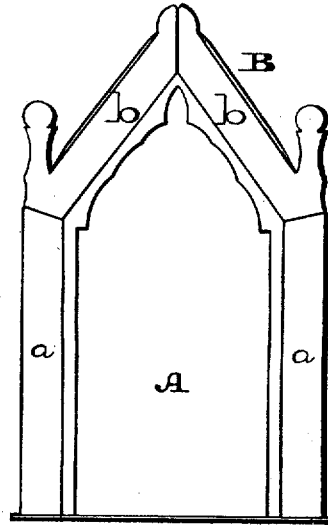

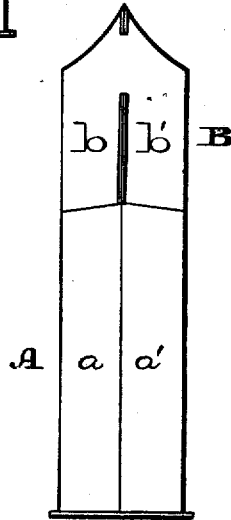
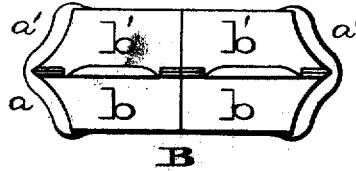

JAMES FALLOWS, OF PHILADELPHIA, PENNSYLVANIA.

DESIGN FOR A TOY MONEY-BOX.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,327**, dated November 27, 1877; application filed November 2, 1877.
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JAMES FALLOWS, of the city and county of Philadelphia, and State of Pennsylvania, have originated a Design for Toy Money-Bank, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, making part of this specification.

Figure 1 is a front view. Fig. 2 is a rear view. Fig. 3 is a side view. Fig. 4 is a top view.

Similar letters of reference indicate corresponding parts in the several figures.

My design consists of the body of the bank having swells on its sides and a peaked roof having swells on its upper face, the swells being formed by pieces meeting and united centrally at the respective parts, thus presenting a neat and attractive design.

Referring to the drawings, A represents the body of the bank, and B the roof, which is peaked. Each side of the body is swelled

outwardly or formed of pieces *a a'*, which unite centrally between the front and back pieces of the body, and the upper face of the roof is swelled upwardly or formed of pieces *b b'*, which unite centrally between the peaked or upper ends of the front and back pieces of the body.

Pinnacles may project centrally from the points of junction of the body and roof. The body and roof may be ornamented with a scalloped cornice and stripings.

What I claim as my invention, is—

The design for a toy bank, the same consisting of the body A, having its sides *a' a'* swelled outwardly, and of a peaked roof, B, having its upper face swelled upwardly, substantially as herein described, and illustrated in the accompanying drawing.
