## DESIGN FOR A BADGE.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,333, dated November 27, 1877; application filed October 27, 1877. [Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ALONZO SCHWARTZ, of New York city, in the county of New York and State of New York, have originated a Design for Badges, of which the following is a clear, full, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying illustration, making part of this specification.

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying illustration, to which reference is made.

A is the center of the badge, which repre-

sents a tiara, or triple crown.

To the sides of the middle crown of the tiara are attached the keys C C, indicating jurisdiction, while the tiara indicates civil rank.

Encircling these emblems is a band, D, joined together at the lower end by a buckle and loop. On the lower part of the band, between the buckle and loop, are placed the

letters "CYMNU." On the upper part of the band are the words "God and our Neighbor."

I do not, however, confine myself to the band or border, as shown, and I do not confine myself to the words and letters placed on said band, as another border, or different words and letters or figures, may be substituted without materially changing the character of my design, the prominent features of which are the tiara and the keys, as shown.

What I claim as my invention is—

The design for a badge, composed of the tiara A and keys C C, surrounded by a band or border, and inscribed substantially as described, and shown in the accompanying draw-
