

DESIGN FOR CUFF AND COLLAR BOX.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,341, dated December 11, 1877; application filed November 10, 1877. [Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ASHER N. LUCHS, of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new and Improved Design for Cuff and Collar Box, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully shown in the accompanying drawing, to which reference

is made.

The object of the invention is to furnish for cuffs and similar articles an improved box of striking and novel design, in which they may be exposed for sale in an attractive and advantageous manner; and the invention consists of a design for a box in the shape of a flower-basket, with base, trunk, and enlarged top piece.

Similar letters of reference indicate corre-

sponding parts.

Referring to the drawing, A represents the base, B the trunk, and C the top section, of my improved cuff and collar box, which is intended to be somewhat of the shape of a flowerbasket or stand.

The base A may be made of cylindrical, conical, or pyramidal shape, the trunk round or

polygonal, corresponding to the shape of the base; and the enlarged top part, that forms the box or receptacle proper, is made of round or polygonal shape, and connected to the trunk by an intermediate portion, D, of inverted conical or pyramidal shape, the part D forming the intermediate member between the trunk and the top section.

The lid or cover E is fitted into the box part, and corresponds in shape therewith. The different parts may be finished or trimmed off in suitable manner, the box forming a neat receptacle for cuffs and collars or similar articles, of peculiar but rather striking appearance.

Having thus fully described my invention, I claim as new and desire to secure by de-

The design for a cuff and collar box, consisting of a base, A, trunk B, intermediate part D, and enlarged top or box part C, substantially as shown and described.
