

## DESIGN FOR BOX-STOVES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,342**, dated December 11, 1877; application filed November 16, 1877. [Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, NICHOLAS S. VEDDER, of the city of Troy, in the county of Rensselaer and State of New York, have invented a new and original Design for Box-Stoves, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying cut.

This invention consists in the design for the side plates and end door, composed of the quadrilateral corner-pieces A, having the rosettes b therein, and the connecting ornamentations C, formed by a fillet, d, bent at right angles, in combination with the plain surface J, and the central panel ornament, composed of the quadrilateral tablet E, having truncated corners f, and the surrounding double-

bead molding g, having on the middle of each side the compound ornament h, with or without the scroll-vinelets i, all shaped and arranged together substantially as shown in the aforesaid cut.

What I claim as my invention is—

The design for the side plates and end door, consisting of the parts A, b, C, d, J, E, f, g, and h, shaped and arranged together as described.
