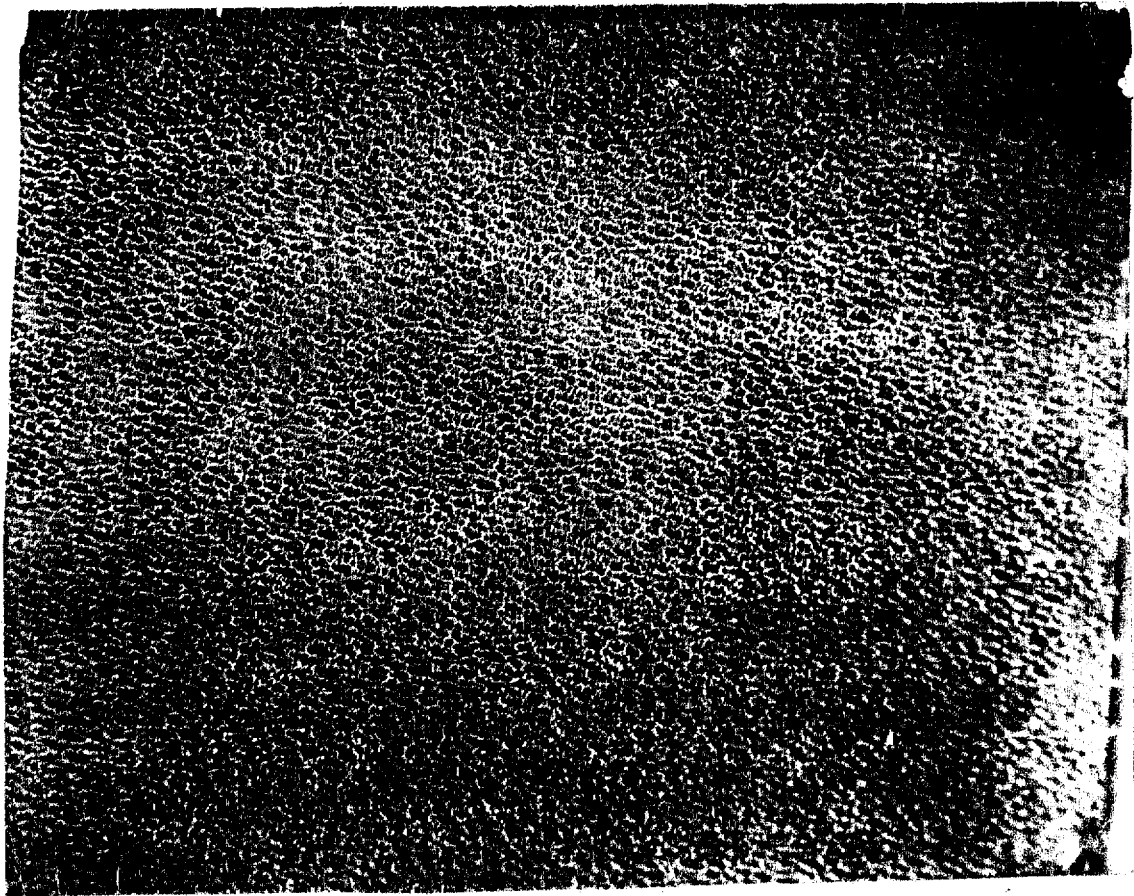

DESIGN FOR RUBBER FABRIC.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,390**, dated January 8, 1878; application filed May 12, 1876.
[Term of Patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, AUGUSTUS O. BOURN, of Bristol, in the county of Bristol and State of Rhode Island, have invented or produced a novel Design for the Ornamentation of the Surface of Rubber Fabrics; and I do hereby declare that the following description, taken in connection with the photograph accompanying the same, is sufficient to enable any person skilled in the art of rubber-working to use my said design.

The surface of the rubber is embossed in close imitation of the surface of that particular class of leather known as "pebbled grain,"

in contradistinction to a certain other class of leather known as "boarded grain," and also in contradistinction to a certain other class known simply as "pebbled."

I claim as my invention and desire to secure by Letters Patent—

The design for the ornamentation of rubber-surfaced fabrics, corresponding substantially with the illustration embodied in the photograph accompanying this specification.
