


## DESIGN FOR HANDLES OF TABLE-WARE.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,395, dated January 8,1878; application filed December 29,1877. [Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, THOMAS MADDOCK, of New York city, in the county and State of New York, have invented a new and improved design for handles, &c., of china, earthen, and metal table-ware, jugs, toilet articles, and the like, of which the following is a specification:

My design is to be known as the "City"

shape, and is fully represented in the draw-

ings.

In the drawings, Figure 1 is a plan view, showing the design applied to the handle of the cover and to the handles at ends of dish. Fig. 2 is a side elevation of the cover. Fig. 3 is an end elevation of a dish with my design applied.

My design includes a solid panel, a, having a suitable ornament, b, raised on the center of

the panel. The panel is surrounded with a raised border, c, rising from the center on the top, and turning into scroll-work at both ends. At each end of the panel, on the cover or dish, there is a suitable raised ornament, e, passing under a strap, d, at each side of the panel, and the cover is a raised line, crossed, and terminating in a scroll, as shown at f.

I claim as my invention— The design substantially as herein set forth. The foregoing specification for an improved design for china, earthenware, metal, &c., signed by me this 11th day of December, A. D. 1877.
