DESIGN FOR A FONT OF PRINTING-TYPES.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,417, dated January 29, 1878; application filed December 17, 1877.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HERMAN IHLENBURG, (assignor to MacKellar, Smiths & Jordan,) of the city and county of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented and originated a new and original Design for a Font of Printing-Types, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is clearly shown in the accompanying typographic impression, to which reference is made; and consists of a letter formed of a heavy plain line upon the right side, connected by plain light lines to

a heavy dotted line, forming the left side, the space between the two heavy lines being filled in with light parallel lines, inclining downward from the right side.

Having now set forth my design, what I claim as new is—

The design for a font of printing-types, as shown and described.
