DESIGN FOR FOUNTAIN-BASIN OR FLOWER-BED.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,418, dated January 29, 1878; application filed January 3, 1878.

[Term of patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WM. TWEEDDALE, of Brooklyn, Kings county, and State of New York, have invented a new and original Design for a Fountain-Basin or Flower-Bed, of which the following is a specification:

My design is fully represented in the accompanying printed engraving, to which reference is made.

The top of the basin is ornamented with the rustic-shaped railings A B, having leaf ornaments in the panels. The sides of the basin are bordered with plain flutes a and ribs b, and the center of each panel is ornamented with the figure-head d, encircling frame e, crown f, side leaf-figures g, and pendant h. The angles of the panels are ornamented with the fluted boss i, scroll-border j, and surmounting leaf-figure k; and between the corner and center figures the sides are ornamented with the Gothic railing l, surmounted by the tips m,

and having the flowering-plant figures n in the spaces between the bars.

What I claim as my design is—

1. The design for the top of a fountainbasin, consisting of the rustic-shaped railings A B, with the leaf-figures C in the panels, as shown.

2. The center of each panel ornamented with the figure-head d, frame e, crown f, side leaf-figures g, and pendant h, as described and shown.

3. The angles of the sides ornamented with the fluted boss i, scroll - border j, and surmounting leaf-figure k, as described and shown.

4. The sides ornamented with the Gothic railing l, with tips m, and flowering plant figures n, as described and shown.
