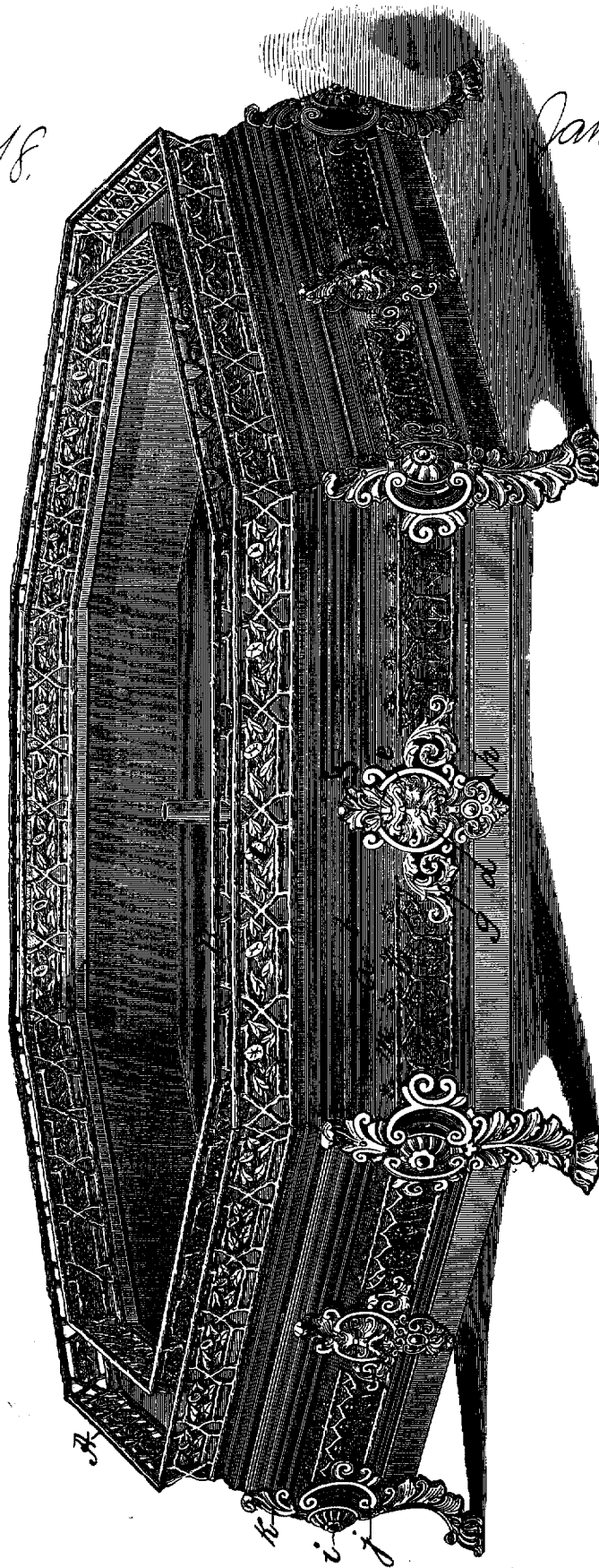

UNITED STATES PATENT OFFICE.

WILLIAM TWEEDDALE, OF BROOKLYN, NEW YORK, ASSIGNOR TO NORTH AMERICAN IRON WORKS, OF SAME PLACE.

DESIGN FOR FOUNTAIN-BASIN OR FLOWER-BED.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,418**, dated January 29, 1878; application filed January 3, 1878.
[Term of patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WM. TWEEDDALE, of Brooklyn, Kings county, and State of New York, have invented a new and original Design for a Fountain-Basin or Flower-Bed, of which the following is a specification:

My design is fully represented in the accompanying printed engraving, to which reference is made.

The top of the basin is ornamented with the rustic-shaped railings A B, having leaf ornaments in the panels. The sides of the basin are bordered with plain flutes *a* and ribs *b*, and the center of each panel is ornamented with the figure-head *d*, encircling frame *e*, crown *f*, side leaf-figures *g*, and pendant *h*. The angles of the panels are ornamented with the fluted boss *i*, scroll-border *j*, and surmounting leaf-figure *k*; and between the corner and center figures the sides are ornamented with the Gothic railing *l*, surmounted by the tips *m*,

and having the flowering-plant figures *n* in the spaces between the bars.

What I claim as my design is—

1. The design for the top of a fountain-basin, consisting of the rustic-shaped railings A B, with the leaf-figures C in the panels, as shown.

2. The center of each panel ornamented with the figure-head *d*, frame *e*, crown *f*, side leaf-figures *g*, and pendant *h*, as described and shown.

3. The angles of the sides ornamented with the fluted boss *i*, scroll-border *j*, and surmounting leaf-figure *k*, as described and shown.

4. The sides ornamented with the Gothic railing *l*, with tips *m*, and flowering-plant figures *n*, as described and shown.
