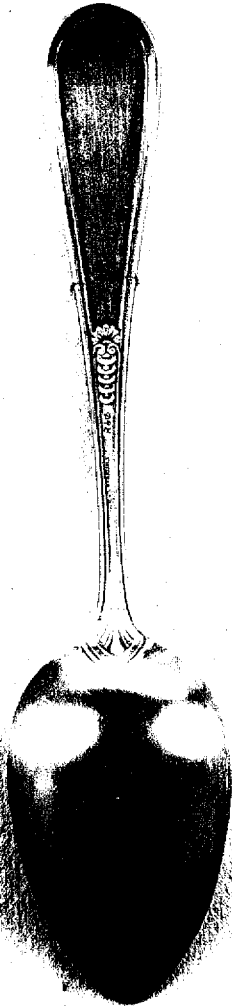

DESIGN FOR HANDLES OF SPOONS AND FORKS.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,420**, dated January 29, 1878; application filed January 7, 1878.
[Term of patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GEORGE WILKINSON, of the city and county of Providence, and State of Rhode Island, have invented a new and original Design for the Handles of Spoons and Forks, in silver and plated wares, of which the following is a specification:

In the accompanying photographs, A represents a front view of the design, the outer edge of which is a raised border line, and inside of this is another raised border line, *a*, separating the two characteristic features of the design. Between these two border lines the ornamentation, commencing at the point *b*, where the two ends of the inner border line meet, is a series of raised elongated points, tapering as they ascend. Immediately under-

neath the point *b* is a series of rosettes, five in number. In the center of the upper portion of the design is a shield, *c*, and surrounding this shield is the prominent feature of the design, consisting of a series of scrolls in the Indian or Hindostanne style of ornamentation, substantially as shown in the photograph.

Figure B represents the reverse view of the said design.

I claim as my invention—

The design for spoon and fork handles, substantially as herein set forth.
