

DANIEL B. WESSON, OF SPRINGFIELD, MASSACHUSETTS.

DESIGN FOR PISTOL-HANDLE.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,421,** dated January 29, 1878; application filed January 11, 1878. [Term of patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, DANIEL B. WESSON, of Springfield, in the county of Hampden and State of Massachusetts, have originated and designed a Pistol-Handle, of which the following, taken in connection with the accompanying drawing, is a full, clear, and accurate description.

The novel features of my design refer, chiefly, to the cheek-pieces forming the butt of the handle.

Figure 1 represents, in side view, a pistolhandle with a cheek-piece embodying my design applied to it; Fig. 2, an end view of such handle, and Fig. 3 a view of the cheek-piece removed.

The metallic portion a of the handle is finished at each side by the addition of a cheekpiece, B, (see Fig. 3,) having its inner edge b concaved, as from 2 to 3, and its outer edge c and butt portion d curved from point 4 to point 3, as shown by the outer black line c.

The butt portion, left smooth, is rounded

from the flat side of the cheek-piece upward, forming curved portions 56, which join with the diamond-shaped escutcheon f. A bead, 7, extends along the edge b, between the points 23, and a bead, 8, from point 4 to the butt d. The upper end of the cheek-piece, above the diced or checked groundwork g, is provided with a polished or smooth portion, h, curved as at 9 10 11, the curves 10 11 extending into the groundwork g.

What I claim as my invention and design for cheek-pieces is—

The cheek-piece having the groundwork g, the top portion h, curved as at 9 10 11, the curved and beaded edges h g, the butt portion h, curved at 5 h, and the escutcher h

d, curved at 5 6, and the escutcheon f.
