

DESIGN FOR COLLAR AND CUFF BOXES.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,435, dated February 5, 1878; application filed November 10, 1877. [Term of patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Asher N. Luchs, of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new and Improved Design for a Cuff and Collar Box, of which the following

is a specification:

This invention has reference to an improved design for a box for cuffs and collars or other purposes; and consists, essentially, of a starshaped box with eight corners, whose cover is raised above the outer corners, and provided with a raised octagonal bead or trimming.

The nature of the design is fully represented in the accompanying drawing, to which refer-

ence is made.

Similar letters of reference indicate corre-

sponding parts.

A in the drawing represents a star-shaped box with eight corners, and B the cover of the same, which rests on the inner corners, and is raised above the plane of the outer remain-

ing corners, imparting thereby a more ornamental character thereto than when the cover is placed in the same plane with the outer corners. The cover B is also provided with a raised ornamental bead or trimming, C, of octagonal shape; or other ornamental device may be arranged in the central part of the cover.

Having thus fully described my invention, I claim as new and desire to secure by Letters

Patent-

The combination of the star-shaped box A, cover B, having a raised portion above the plane of the outer corners, and octagonal bead C, to form a new design in cuff and collar boxes, as shown and described.
