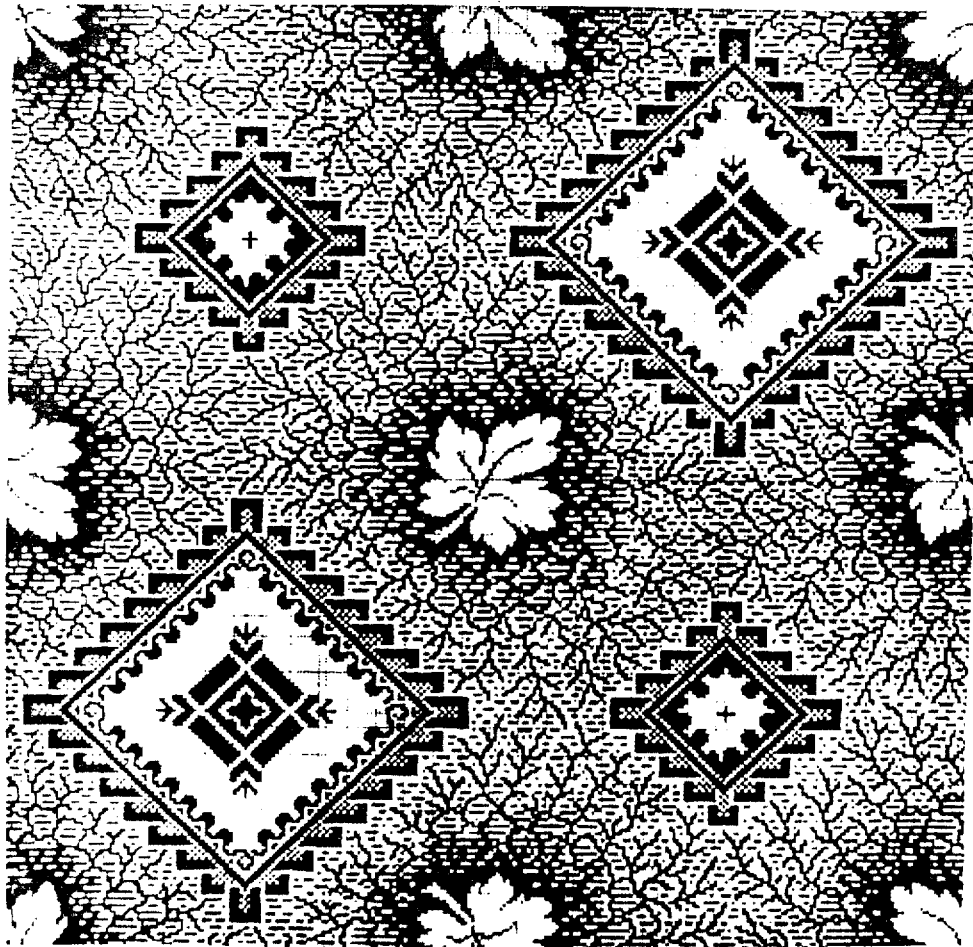

DESIGN FOR CARPETS.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,480**, dated February 19, 1878; application filed February 5, 1878.
[Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ELEMIR J. NEY, of the city of Lowell, county of Middlesex, and State of Massachusetts, have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Pattern to be Inwrought in Two or Three Ply Ingrain and other Carpeting, in such colors as may be desired; and I do hereby declare that the photographic print accompanying this specification conveys to any one skilled in the art of carpet-weaving a clear understanding

of the same, and is sufficient to enable such person to use my invention.

What I claim as my invention, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for ornamenting ingrain or other carpeting, as shown in the photographic print accompanying this specification.
