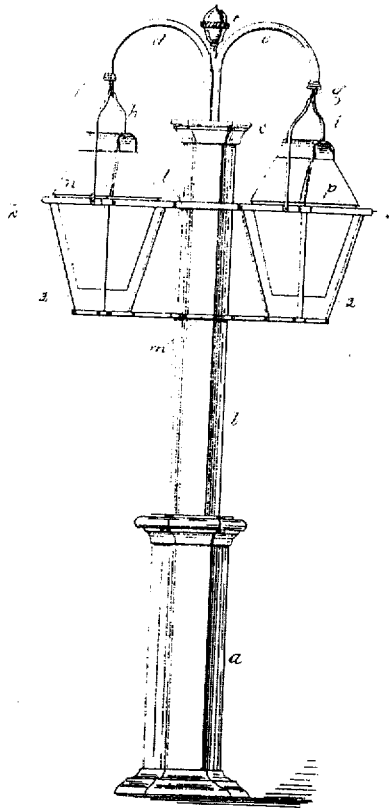

## DESIGN FOR STREET OR PARK LAMP.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,497**, dated February 19, 1878; application filed January 18, 1878.  
[Term of patent 14 years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, GEORGE D. BURTON, of New Ipswich, Hillsborough county, State of New Hampshire, have originated and designed a Street or Park Lamp, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, making a part of this specification, wherein is represented the nature of my design.

The post is composed of a base portion, *a*, and a smaller guiding portion, *b*, above it, a collar, *c*, projecting from the upper end of *b*. At the top of the post are two arches, *d e*, from which extend chains *f g*, connected with bails *h i*, joined with the lamp-carriages *j k*, connected together at top by a loop, *l*, and at bottom by a loop, *m*, such loops embracing the portion *b* of the post, to slide up and down thereon, and guide and steady the lamp car-

riage as it is raised and lowered to light or extinguish the lamps *n p*.

The top and bottom bars of the carriage are joined by a series of rods, *2*. The ends of the chain within the post are connected with a weight, to counterbalance the weight of the carriage and lamps. Between the arches is an ornamental top part or acorn, *r*.

I claim—

The design for a lamp-post, consisting of the post *a b*, carriage *j k l m 2*, bails *h i*, lamps *n p*, chains, and arches, all substantially as shown and described.
