

DESIGN FOR A SHIRT-FRONT.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,499, dated February 19, 1878; application filed December 17, 1877. [Term of patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, John Hope, of the city and county of Providence, and State of Rhode Island, have originated a Design for a Shirt-Front, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, making part of this specification.

The drawing represents a shirt front on which a collar and neck-tie are represented, and the body of the front ornamented in any manner desired, so as to produce any desired effect.

A represents the shirt-front proper, ornamented in any manner to represent any kind of striped, plain, or figured goods. B is a representation of a shirt-collar. C represents a neck-tie, and may be of any desired form or color. D are emblematic or other designs, which may be produced on either or both the shirt-front or collar. E is a marginal line, forming a guide for cutting the shirt-front

from the material on which the design is produced.

This design may be produced by printing, stamping, or embossing on cloth or other suitable material. The design may be produced by embossing and partially coloring of any desired portion, by stamping or printing in any desired color or variety of colors, or in any other manner by which the desired effect can be produced, and either on one or both sides of the material.

What I claim as my invention is—

A design for shirt-front, consisting of the representation of a shirt-bosom, turn-down collar, and neck-tie, substantially as described, and shown in the accompanying illustration.
