## DESIGN FOR CARPETS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,514, dated March 12, 1878; application filed March 1, 1878. [Term of patent 31 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ETIENNE GUIRAUD, of the city of New York, county and State of New York, have invented a new and original Design for a Carpet, of which the following is a specification:
The accompanying photograph illustrates

my new design.

This invention relates to a new design for a carpet, oil-cloth, or similar fabric.

It consists of representations of groups of flowers, A, in which daisies, a, and lilies of the

valley, b, are most conspicuous. Ferns and leaves, c, are also interspersed with the flowers. Between these larger groups, A, are smaller groups, d, of flowers and leaves, as shown.

I claim as my invention—
The design for a carpet, substantially as shown.
