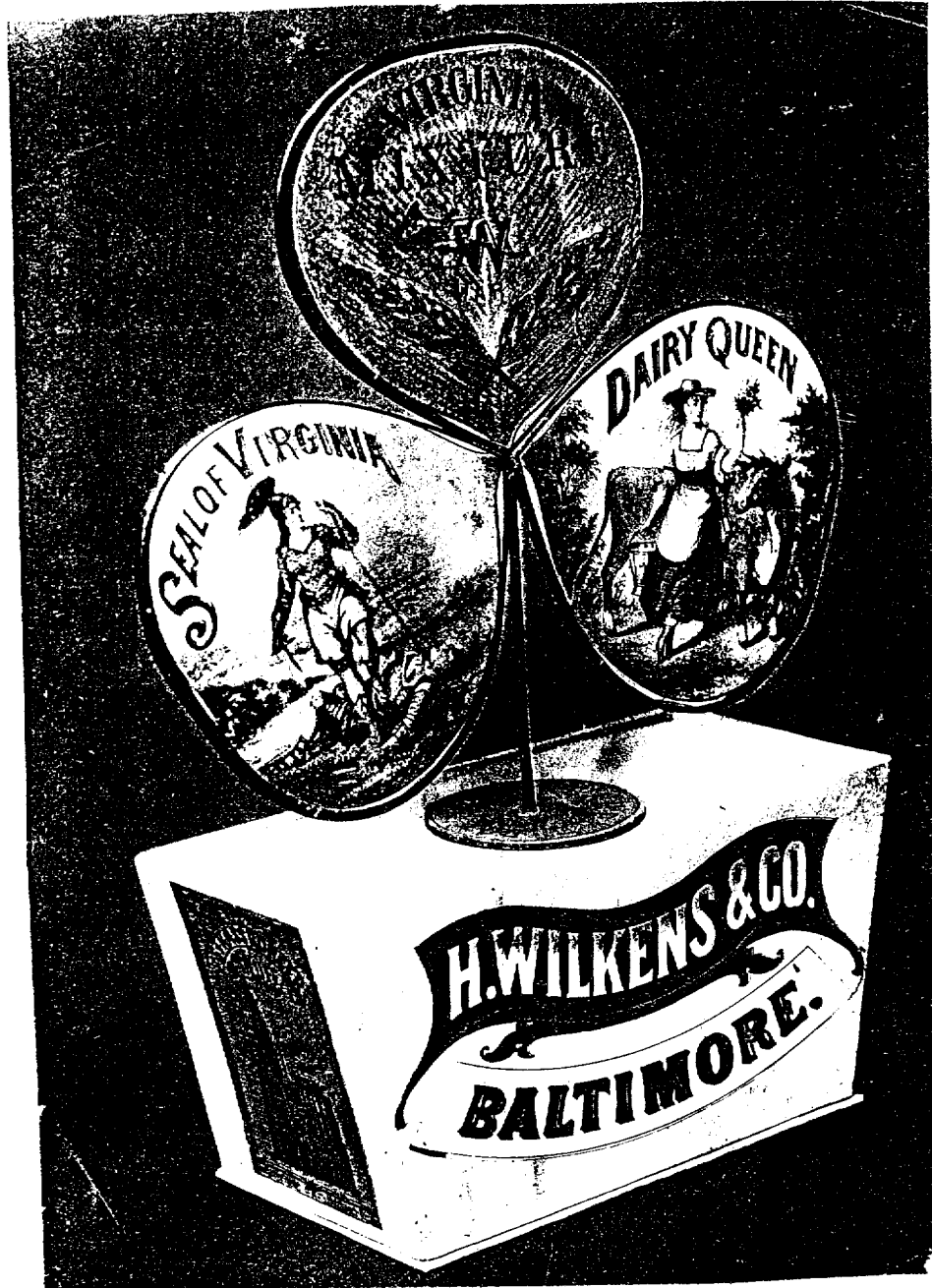

DESIGN FOR SAMPLE-BOX.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,614**, dated April 2, 1878; application filed February 4, 1878.
[Term of patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ERICH L. WITTHAUS, of the city of Baltimore, in the county of Baltimore and State of Maryland, have originated and produced a new and useful Design of a Sample-Box, which design is fully set forth in the following specification and accompanying photographs.

The object of my design is to furnish a box having an ornamental device situated upon it, the whole presenting a beautiful appearance, and serving as an ornament to a show-window in tobacco and other shops.

My box A has the ordinary flat sides and top and bottom, but with slanting ends C. At the bottom of my box a rim, *a*, is shown of a box that is placed into the box A from be-

low. Upon the box, and forming a part of my design, is a standard, D, having a base, E, and at its upper end branch off three leaves or wings, 1 2 3. Upon or covering these hoops I place advertisements, pictures, or other ornamental designs, as may be desired. The standard presents the appearance of a three-leaved clover, as will be seen.

What I claim is—

The design herein described, consisting of the box A *c a*, base E, standard D, and leaves 1 2 3.
