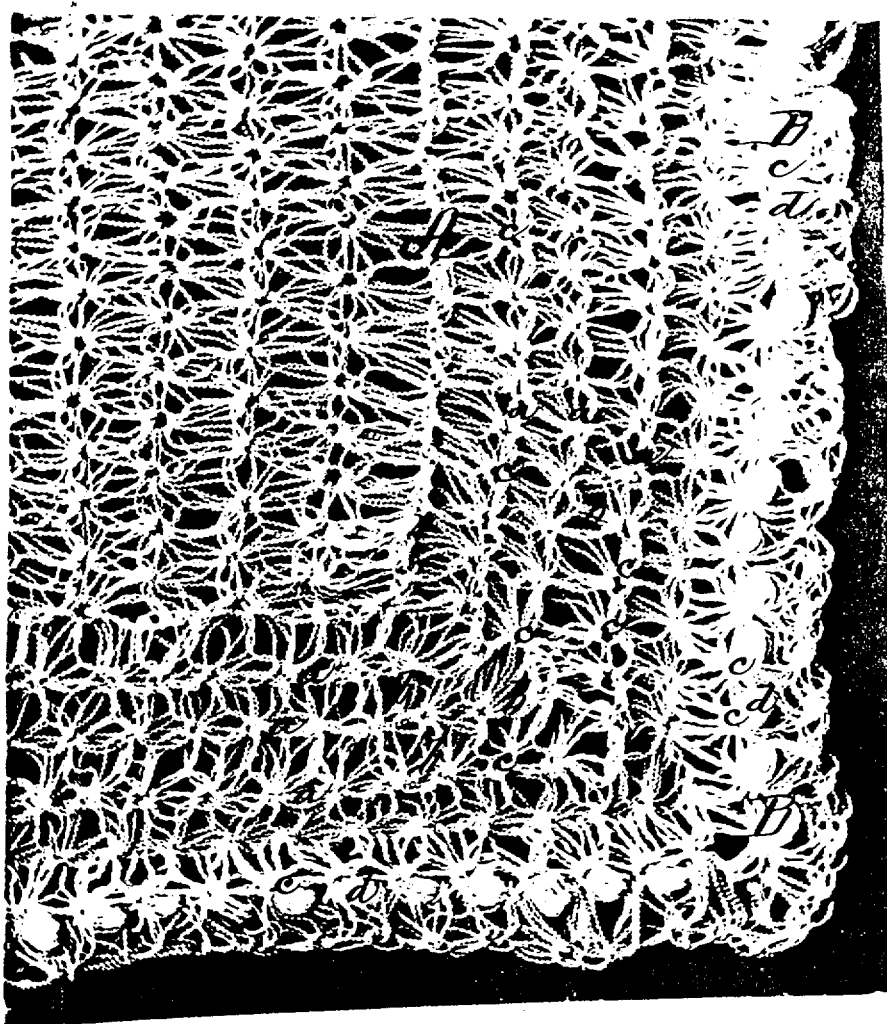

## DESIGN FOR A CROCHET FABRIC.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,626**, dated April 16, 1878; application filed March 1, 1878.  
[Term of patent 3½ years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, CAROLINE A. BURNHAM, of West Somerville, in the county of Middlesex and State of Massachusetts, have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Stitch for Crocheted Fabrics, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying photograph, making part of this specification.

My invention relates to a unique and ornamental stitch for crocheted work, whereby a beautiful fabric is produced.

In the said photograph, A represents a crochet fabric, which may be formed of crimped or plain yarn or thread, the stitch by which this fabric is made producing a series of parallel ribs, *a*, loosely connected by a series of loops, *b*, which radiate from centers *c*, located on the lines of the ribs, the whole forming a series of star-shaped figures, the fabric thus made presenting a beautiful and unique ap-

pearance. An ornamental border, B, is produced around the article by forming a puff or ball, *d*, of tightly-drawn loops outside each of the centers *c* thereof.

What I claim as my invention, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

1. The design for a crochet fabric, consisting of a series of parallel ribs, *a*, connected by a series of loops, *b*, radiating from centers *c* on the lines of the ribs, the whole forming a series of star-shaped figures, substantially as herein shown and described.

2. The design of the border B, with its puffs *d* located outside the centers *c* thereof, substantially as herein shown and described.
