

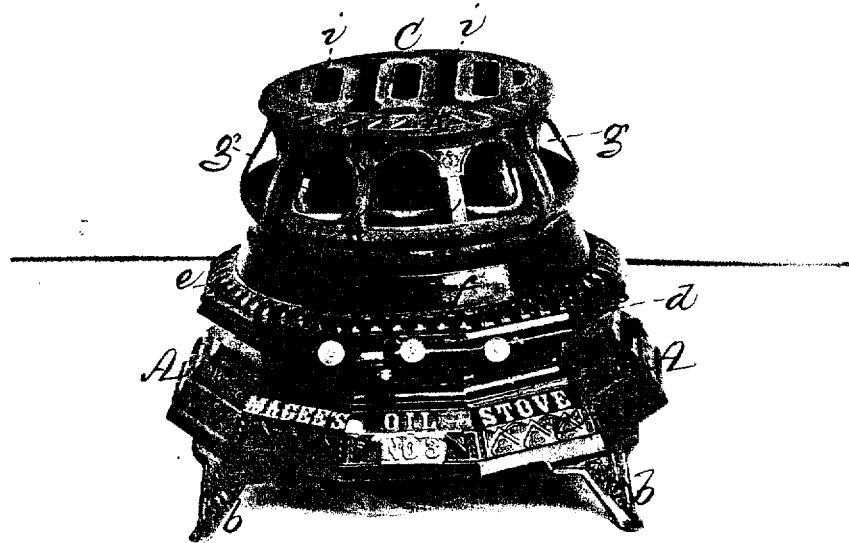

DESIGN FOR OIL-STOVES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,657**, dated April 30, 1878; application filed April 20, 1878.
[Term of patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, FRANK A. MAGEE, of Chelsea, in the county of Suffolk and State of Massachusetts, have invented and produced a new and original Design for an Oil-Stove, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying photograph, making part of this specification.

In the photograph, A represents the base of the stove, which is supported by four legs, *b*, each of which is provided on its front face with ornamental work.

The base A, which slopes inward and upward, is of the form of a twelve-sided polygon, and is embellished with an ornamental molding, *c*. Immediately above the base A is located the upper outside edge *d* of the oil-tank, having twelve faces or sides, corresponding to those of the base A.

B is the upper portion of the stove, which is hinged to allow of its being thrown back, and rests upon the upper edge of the oil-tank, the base of the portion B having twelve sides, to correspond to those of the oil-tank and

base A, and being provided with an ornamental open-work molding, *e*, immediately above which is a smooth tapering portion, *f*.

The upper part of the stove is provided with a series of arched openings, *g*, through which the flame is seen, the partings being embellished with ornamental work *h*, as seen, the whole being surmounted by a cap, C, provided with apertures *i*, and an ornamental molding, *k*, extending around it near the outer edge.

What I claim as my invention, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

1. The design for an oil-stove composed, essentially, of the base A and portion B, with their moldings and ornamental work, substantially as herein shown and described.

2. The design of the portion B, with its openings *g* and perforated cap C, substantially as shown and described.
