

DESIGN FOR SUMMER-PIECE OR REGISTER-FRONT.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,680, dated May 14, 1878; application filed May 6, 1878. [Term of patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOSEPH A. READ, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a new and useful Design for Summer-Piece or Register-Front, of which the following is a specification:

My design is fully illustrated in the accompanying drawing, Figure 1 of which shows the register-front with round top, and Fig. 2

the same with flat top.

The design comprises an open-work border, a, two frames, b and d, which follow the contour of the border, a central ornament, e, and intervening ornamental work of a character too fully shown to need minute description.

The central ornament consists of a rosette and two concentric rings, the rosette and rings

being connected by radiating or spoke-like ornaments.

I claim-

The design for a register-front or summerpiece for fire-places, said design comprising the border a, frames b d, central ornament e, and intervening ornamentation, all substantially as described, and as shown in and by

the accompanying drawing.
