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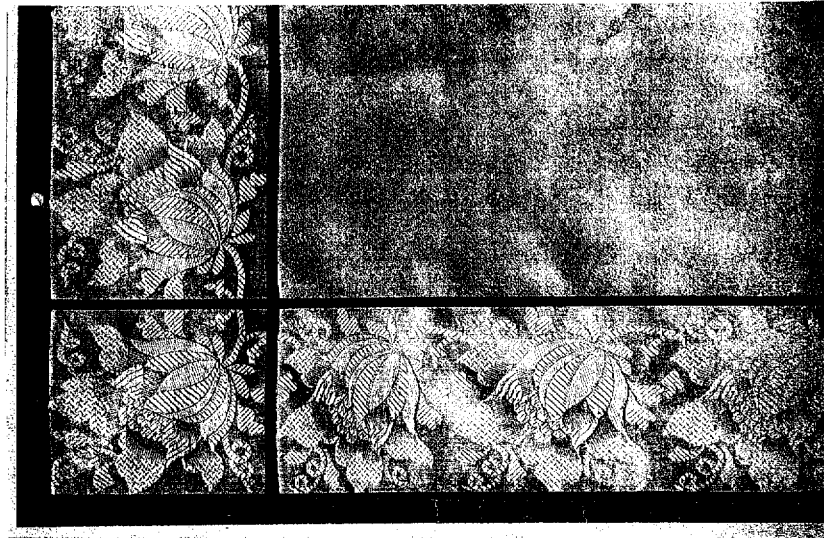

## DESIGN FOR HANDKERCHIEF.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,703**, dated May 23, 1878; application filed May 10, 1878.  
[Term of patent  $3\frac{1}{2}$  years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, JOHN GRIMSHAW, of Paterson, in the county of Passaic and State of New Jersey, have invented a new and original Design for Handkerchief, of which the following is a specification:

A represents the body of the handkerchief, and B a portion of the border. The body is woven with a granite or frosted surface. The border consists of a wide stripe of damask or Jacquard work, separated from the body at each side by a narrow satin stripe. These stripes cross each other at the corners, and extend to the outer edges of the handkerchief.

The damask border is surrounded on its outer edges by a satin stripe. Suitable colors should be employed to produce harmonious effects.

I claim as my invention—

A design for a handkerchief, in which the body consists of a granite or frost surface, and the border is composed of a wide stripe of damask or Jacquard work inclosed by two satin stripes, substantially as above described.
