## DESIGN FOR WOODEN CIGAR-LIGHTER.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,707**, dated June 4, 1878; application filed March 21, 1878.  
[Term of patent 7 years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that we, NATHANIEL FULLER and JOSEPH A. BROWN, both of Boston, in the county of Suffolk and State of Massachusetts, have jointly originated and designed Ornamental Wood Spirals, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, making part of this specification.

The nature of our design is fully represented in the accompanying drawing, to which reference is made.

Our design for wood spirals consists in providing such spirals with a colored spiral band or end, which band or end may be of any desired color or colors, and the said colored spiral band may be of any desired width or depth from the end. For instance, we make it as a very narrow stripe upon the edge or end of the wooden spiral, or as wide as the wooden

spiral itself, and any and all graduations between such extremes. Wooden spirals so colored and ornamented form a very attractive and beautiful design for ornamental purposes.

In the drawing, *a* shows the spiral, and *b* shows its colored edge or band, running spirally from top to bottom thereof, as shown.

What we claim as our invention is—

The herein-described design for ornamental wood spirals, composed of a colored spiral edge or band of suitable width, in the manner above set forth.
